

# Moore Museum's Christmas Craft

What you need:

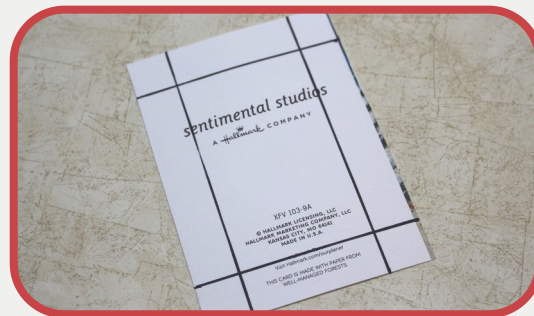
- Christmas Cards
- Scissors
- Ruler and pencil
- Clear tape OR glue
- Yarn
- Hole punch

**1** Choose a Christmas card. The best ones for this activity have an image right in the center, and words centered inside as well.

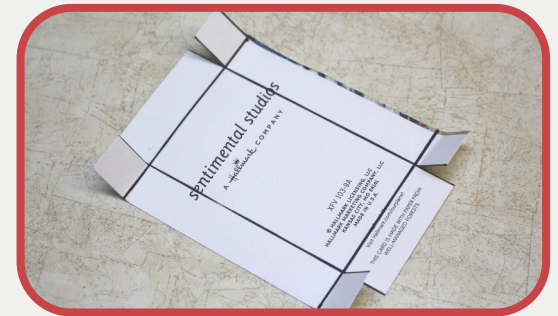
**2** Cut the card in half along the folded line. Take the back of the card, and cut 3mm off of the top and one side. This will make the bottom of the box slightly smaller than the lid, and help them fit together.



**3** Draw four lines on the back of each piece. The lines should all be 2cm away from the edge.



**4** Make 4 small cuts along the lines that you have drawn, as shown in the image below.



**5** Fold each side along the lines you have drawn, and secure the corners with tape.



**6** Use a hole punch to make a hole at the top of the lid of your box. Put the lid back on, and make a small pencil mark through the hole. Make another hole where your pencil mark is. String some yarn through the holes and tie it in a knot!
